The Rise of Radio, from Marconi through the Golden Age

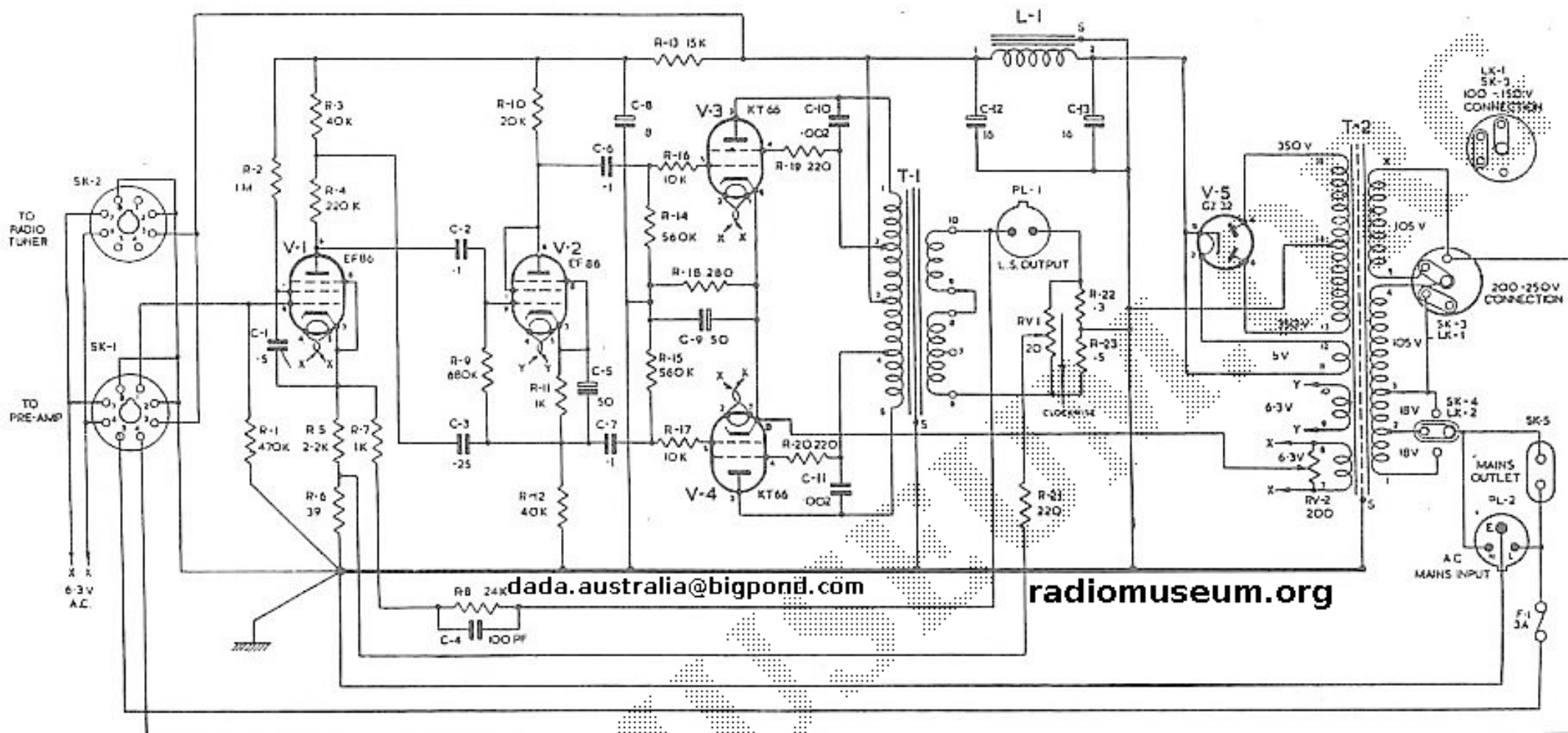
